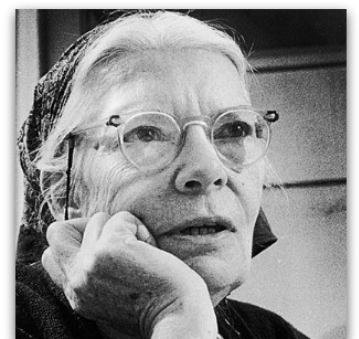


# Haunted by God: The Life of Dorothy Day
